Young Wizards,

We are pleased to inform you that you have a place at Torhunta District's Wizarding World of Scouting! Term begins Thursday, July 19<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 a.m. Please check-in at King's Cross Station, located at Old Waynesborough Park, starting at 8:15 a.m. Please remember to wear tennis shoes, since we will be hiking every day. Also, each Wizard should bring sunscreen & a water bottle.

*This camp is for all registered Cub Scouts & their siblings. New this year, we are offering a Half Day Camper or Full Day Camper option.*

- **Half Day Campers** - Half Day Campers attend camp from 8:30-12:30. Half Day Campers will not receive lunch on Thursday & Friday, but they will receive lunch on Saturday during family day. The cost for Half Day Campers is \$45.
- **Full Day Campers** - Full Day Campers attend camp from 8:30-4:30. They will eat lunch at The Three Broomsticks Inn all 3 days. We may even have Polyjuice Potion or Butterbeer to accompany your meal! The cost for Full Day Campers is \$55.

**Wizarding Fun** - Once wizards have been assigned to their house, they will visit Diagon Alley. At Madam Malkin's Robes for All Occasions, they will craft house scarfs. At Honey Dukes, they will craft Origami Jumping Frogs. At Ollivander's Wand Shop, wizards will craft their scout wand.

Most Wizards will have a Defense Against the Dark Arts class on Thursday & Friday. During this class wizards will play Quidditch and Wizard Checkers. All wizards will also have Potions Class, where slime and fizz are abundant. In Charms Class, wizards will practice basic spells with their wands, like Wingardium Leviosa.

*Classes for First through Fifth year wizards are as follows. Please note that Full Day Campers will attend all classes listed below. Half Day Campers will attend half of the classes listed below:*

- **First Year Wizards (Lions & Tigers)** - Backyard Jungle; Games Tigers Play; Tigers In The Wild; Curiosity, Intrigue & Magical Mysteries; Tiger Tag; and Tiger Tales.
- **Second Year Wizards** - Council Fire; Howling At The Moon; Paws On The Path; Code Of The Wolf; Digging In The Past; Finding Your Way with the Marauders' Map
- **Third Year Wizards** - Bear Necessities; Baloo The Builder (Wand Plaques); Gobstones (Marble Madness); Roaring Laughter; and Super Science (Potions)
- **Fourth Year Wizards** - WEBELOS Walkabout; Adventures In Science; Build It (Wand Plaques); Game Design; and Sportsman (Defense Against The Dark Arts)
- **Fifth Year Wizards** - Outdoorsman; Adventures In Science; Build It (Wand Plaques); Game Design; and Sportsman (Defense Against The Dark Arts)



**Family Day** - On Saturday, July 21<sup>st</sup>, we invite your family to accompany you to Wizarding School. This includes lunch at The Three Broomsticks Inn! We may even have Polyjuice Potion or Butterbeer to accompany your feast. You can register your entire family for only \$10!

Hogwarts Boat Races, Potions & Dueling Class, Centaur Archery Class, Metal Wand (BB) Class, Spell Slinger Class, and The Torhunta Wizards Tournament are just a hint of the many fun activities that await the adventurous wizard and his family!

**Who Can Attend** - This camp is for all registered Cub Scouts & their siblings. One adult volunteer per every one to five Scouts and siblings from each participating den or pack is required. All Tiger Cubs must have an adult partner with them at all times. Don't delay, register today!

**Cost:**

- 1) **\$55/Full Day Camper** - the camp fee includes lunch, t-shirt, supplies, Sphinx Slushy on Saturday and patch for each camper
- 2) **\$45/Half Day Camper** - the camp fee includes a t-shirt, supplies, lunch on Saturday, Sphinx slushy on Saturday and patch for each camper
- 3) **\$10/family** - You can register your entire family for Family Day on Saturday for only \$10! This includes lunch and program supplies! This section only has to be completed once per family if you are completing multiple camper registration forms.
- 4) **Adults can order a Cub Scout Day Camp t-shirt for \$12.00.** Indicate name and size on the registration form

**Registering** - Please send the form on page 3 to the Tuscarora BSA Council Office to register. Please complete one Registration form per camper. We await your Owl no later than Thursday, July 5<sup>th</sup>. A \$10.00 late fee will be incurred for any registrations after this deadline & your scout will not be guaranteed a T-Shirt.
